Frequently asked questions about 90DayMyWay

What is 90DayMyWay?

Under your pharmacy benefit plan, all long-term medicines must be filled in a 90-day supply. 90DayMyWay is a program that helps you get your long-term medicines in one of two ways: You can choose to fill at an extended supply network pharmacy or use home delivery.

How do I switch to a retail Pharmacy?

Ask your doctor to switch your prescriptions to a 90-day supply (or, your pharmacist can ask your doctor to change your prescription).

How do I switch to home delivery?

Log in to your **BlueCare Connect** account or call 1-833-721-1627.

Once you've signed up for home delivery, contact your doctor to switch your prescription(s) to Amazon Pharmacy.

What are long term medicines?

Long-term medicines are those taken regularly for more than three months to treat chronic conditions such as high cholesterol, high blood pressure, asthma, depression or anxiety.

How do I find an extended supply network Pharmacy?

Log in to your BlueCare Connect account to find a pharmacy that offers 90-day supplies. There are over 52,000 in your extended supply network*, including:

- Stop and Shop®
- CVS Pharmacy™
- Community Pharmacy Network (includes several independent pharmacies)

*Walgreens and Rite Aid Pharmacies are not part of the Extended Supply Network
